- Owner must be able to present proof of current canine vaccinations
- ACS reserves the right to turn away any dog considered a threat to other dogs or participants
- Canine owners should respect each dog’s space
- Each dog must be accompanied by an owner
- Dogs must be leashed at all times
- A maximum 6’ leash must be used during the walk
- Dogs in heat are not permitted
- Owners must clean up after their pet (doggie clean-up bags will be provided)
- Owners under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult
- A veterinarian will be available at the site
- All registration fees for the Bark For Life Event will go to the American Cancer Society Relay For Life of Newton County; all day-of income (including activities, fundraisers, contests, etc.) also go to the American Cancer Society Relay For Life of Newton County
- I also give my full permission for such first aid as is deemed necessary to be provided to me or my dog/dogs on the premises or prior to transport to a medical facility for further treatment.
